

AD 1.2 RESCUE AND FIREFIGHTING SERVICES AND SNOW PLAN**1 RESCUE AND FIREFIGHTING SERVICES**

1.1 At all aerodromes where flying takes place, Rescue and Fire Fighting Services, and in some cases also Sea Rescue Services, are established in accordance with regulations for civil aviation. Sea Rescue services in the State of Qatar are the responsibility of the Coast and Border Security Department (Coastguard).

Note: For heliports special rules will apply

1.2 Information about whether there is a service or not and also the extent of the service is given on the relevant page for each aerodrome.

1.3 Scheduled or non - scheduled traffic with aeroplanes carrying passengers are not allowed to use aerodromes without Rescue and Fire Fighting Services.

1.4 Each individual service is categorised to the table shown below. Temporary changes will be published by NOTAM.
